The Great Neck Public School district has provided your child with an iPad and, if requested, a brick and charger, for use while he or she is a student at Great Neck South High School. When your child graduates, or leaves South High School prior to graduation, these items must be returned. We have reviewed the Acceptable Use policy with your child and he/she has indicated his/her understanding of this policy through a survey in the Student Portal. This policy includes expected behaviors of digital citizenship, technical requirements such as making sure that only your child's school iTunes account is used on the iPad, safety concerns such as not sharing his/her password, and requiring students to leave location services on so a lost iPad can be found. This policy also includes the costs associated with a lost or damaged iPad or accessories. Good digital citizenship is an important facet of behavior in our evolving digital world. In particular, students must respect the privacy of others and refrain from taking and posting pictures or recordings of anyone without that person's consent.
