NYS-APPROVED DRIVER EDUCATION – SUMMER 2018

Applications will be processed beginning February 26, 2018, and will be processed in the order in which they are received. Applications received after May 24, 2018, will only be considered if space remains.

Learner Permit Receipt Deadline: June 22, 2018.

Enrollment Requirements

- You must be a high school student who resides in the Great Neck school district, be at least 16 years of age by June 22, 2018, and have a valid learner permit by June 22, 2018. If you have not made arrangements to obtain your learner permit, please refer to the New York State DMV website for detailed information. **A copy of your Learner Permit must be received before the first class. No exceptions.**

Course Information

- **Theory class meets Monday June 25 through Tuesday, July 24 (no class Friday, June 29, Wed/Thu/Fri, July 4, 5, & 6, Friday, July 13, and Friday, July 20). (make-up may be required) Theory class will end approximately 2 weeks before driving instruction, which continues into the first weeks of August (see schedule on next page).**
- This 16-session, morning program includes 24 hours of classroom instruction, homework, a midterm, and final; and 24 hours of driving instruction, including observation, with each student spending 6 hours behind the wheel; additional driving practice, outside of class, is required (see next paragraph).
- Recent changes in the New York State driving laws include an increase in the number of supervised driving hours required before scheduling a road test: **50 hours, including 15 hours of driving after sunset. In addition, if you are under 18, learner permit status must be held for 6 months before a road test may be scheduled.**

Application Procedure

- Application must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian and must include payment and information requested. Incomplete applications will not be processed. Please return the completed application by mail to the above address, or by fax to the above fax number, as soon as possible. If you have already obtained your learner permit, be sure to include a copy with your application. Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. **Phone registrations are not accepted.**

Tuition and Refund Policy

- Tuition is \$575. On withdrawal before the start of the semester, a refund minus \$30 will be issued. After the start of the semester, there are no refunds. Financial assistance is available to students eligible for free or reduced lunch on file with the

school district; confirmation letter from Food and Nutrition should be attached to application.

Location

- **All Summer Classes** are held at the Community Education building located at 30 Cumberland Avenue; Theory class will meet in a classroom. Cars depart from, and return to Cumberland after the lesson. Students may not be dropped off at other locations.

Attendance

- **Attendance at all Driving Groups and Theory Classes is mandatory. According to State Law, any absence and/or lateness must be made up. If you abuse this requirement, you will be dropped from the program without refund of fees. Before you register, please be sure that you can attend and that you can be on time for all sessions.**

Upon Completion

- Students who successfully complete the requirements for this non-credit course will receive a Student Certificate of Completion (MV285), which includes an Insurance Premium Reduction certificate. The Certificate will be issued on the last day of driving class for the summer semester. The MV285 permits a student to obtain a New York State senior license at age 17.
- **Students and parents should note that, after receiving the MV285 and passing the road test, a 17-year-old is eligible for a senior license after holding learner permit status for at least 6 months; a 16-year-old will be eligible for a junior license. Students with a junior license may not drive to school and cannot drive on their own without necessary employment certification.**
- **Parents and students should familiarize themselves with the student driving laws of New York State, as well as with the Great Neck Public Schools Board of Education Policy 5454 Student Driving (which can be found on the District Web site).**
- **Without completion of a state-approved Driver Education program, a New York States senior license is not issued until age 18.**
